**The Suburban Ramsey Emergency Coalition** brings together Lions, Rotary, Kiwanis, and Optimists with the Roseville Area and Shoreview Community Foundations for a specific mission: to assist vulnerable and underserved neighbors within our communities who are suffering the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic. We do this by providing funds, goods, and volunteers to those non-profit organizations who are providing direct relief to those most in need. Our focus is the area of ISD's 621 and 623, which include Mounds View, New Brighton, Arden Hills, Shoreview, Roseville, Falcon Heights, Lauderdale and Little Canada.

Some of our activities to date:

- The Coalition awarded its first three grants to assist with housing instability and food insecurity. These grants, each for \$5000, were awarded to the Community Support Center, Keystone Community Services, and Neighborhood House.
- Volunteers produced and delivered 50 fabric isolation gowns for the Ramsey County Care Center. And this was only Phase I of the project! The goal is a total of 200 gowns.
- We reached a third of our fundraising goal of \$150,000, thanks to the generosity of our members and supporters.
- We are planning our first fundraising event, a 3 mile virtual run/walk. Stay tuned for information!
